


Eggbert's Adventures™

INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO MAKE EGGBERT'S EGG CAR AND CHARACTERS™

YOU WILL NEED:

1. Adult supervision
2. One egg box
3. Scissors
4. Pen or felt tip marker
5. Cotton wool
6. Screwdriver for making holes
7. Four wheels, each 5cm in diameter (across)
8. Good glue (such as copydex, airfix etc.)
9. Two eggs, boiled and hollowed
10. Paint and brush or coloured felt pens
11. Two 14cm lengths of dowel, plastic tube or wooden screwers


STEP 1



CUT OFF THE LID AT (A)
AND THE LID SECURING
FLAP AT (B).



STEP 2



CUT THE LID
IN HALF
ALONG LINE
A.

CUT ALONG B
1/3 OF THE
WAY DOWN
THE LID,
MAKING SURE
THERE IS
SPACE FOR
TWO EGGS TO
SIT IN THEIR
SEATS.



STEP 3

BOTTOM OF EGG BOX.



CUT OFF THE TOPS OF
THE TWO CONE
SHAPES.




TURN THEM OVER
AND FILL THE HOLES
WHICH HAVE BEEN
MADE.

STEP 4

SIDE VIEW




MAKE 4 HOLES, 2 ON EACH SIDE AS SHOWN



CUT 2 PIECES OF DOWEL, PLASTIC TUBE OR WOODEN SCREWERS INTO 14cm LENGTHS.


END VIEW



PUSH DOWELS THROUGH THE HOLES UNTIL THEY GO RIGHT THROUGH THE EGG BOX.

STEP 5 USING GLUE, STICK THE LID ONTO THE BASE. THIS WILL GIVE THE CAR A BONNET.

STICK THE SECURING FLAP TO THE BACK OF THE CAR, MAKING SURE THE CURVED EDGE IS FACING THE BONNET. THIS WILL GIVE THE CAR A HEAD REST.



FIX WHEELS TO DOWELS.

CUT 4 WHEELS FROM CARD 5cm ACROSS AND MAKE A HOLE IN THE CENTRE. YOU COULD ALSO USE WOODEN OR PLASTIC WHEELS.

STEP 6

CUT THE TOP OFF TWO BOILED EGGS SCOOP OUT THE EGG AND EAT FOR BREAKFAST



TURN THE EMPTY EGG SHELLS OVER AND FILL WITH COTTON WOOL. HANDLE THEM GENTLY. CHANGE THE SHELLS INTO EGG CHARACTERS USING FELT PENS, MARKERS OR PAINT.



STEP 7

PAINT THE CAR IN YOUR FAVOURITE COLOUR. WHEN IT IS DRY PUT COTTON WOOL INTO THE EGG BOX HOLLOW. THEN PUT YOUR EGG PEOPLE IN THE CAR.
